- 2) Stock of black tea as on 31<sup>st</sup> December, 2022 has been valued at lower of cost (which is based on estimated cost of production and expenditure for the financial year ending 31<sup>st</sup> March, 2023) and net realisable value. Production and expenditure not being uniform throughout the year, stock valuation will be unrealistic if it is based on actual production and expenditure up to 31<sup>st</sup> December, 2022. The aforesaid method of valuation of stock is consistent with the accounting policy followed by the Company in earlier years for the purpose of publishing quarterly results. Valuation of stock of tea at the end of the financial year will be as per the applicable Indian Accounting Standard(s).
- 3) Value of green leaf produced in the Company's own tea estates is not ascertainable. However, cost of materials consumed represents only cost of green leaf purchased from others.
- 4) The Company is engaged in the business of cultivation, production and sale of black tea which is seasonal in nature, and as such, the above results for the quarter and nine months ended 31<sup>st</sup> December, 2022 are not indicative of the results for the full financial year.
- 5) Tax expense, including current tax and deferred tax, if any, is recognised at the end of the financial year.
- 6) Liability on account of defined benefit obligation has been provided on estimated basis. Actuarial valuation of defined benefit obligation will be made at the end of the financial year and actuarial gain / loss, if any, will be recognised at that time.
- 7) Measurement of fair value of investment in equity shares will be carried out at the end of the financial year, when the extent of impairment or enhancement, if any, will be ascertained.
- 8) The Company has only one business segment of manufacture and sale of black tea.
